Team Snap Links for Divisional Managers and Team Managers

At Season Start:

- 1. Divisional Managers will have access to their Division in Team Snap. They will be set up with full access. For U11 and above they will be set up with access to two different teams as well as their division Rep Tryout Players and House Tryout Players.
- 2. Near the end of the tryouts the Ice Allocator will set up the appropriate number of teams for their division A/B and C1/C2/C3 etc and will upload the practice schedules for each team. If your assessments are complete please contact the iceallocator@pmha.bc.ca and ask them to set up your teams and upload the practice schedule. Once teams are set up you will then be able to begin rostering your players and team coaches.
- 3. The Divisional Managers will then roster the players in their division to the teams they will be on and publish the rosters.
- 4. They will give the head coach and manager non player manager access to their team and from that point forward the Manager and Head Coach will assume responsibility for these teams and can edit schedules, add other non playing personal that need access etc.
- 5. Managers will also need to make sure that their players and team volunteers complete their availability and Health Check certification before each team session that is in Team Snap.

Please Note:

For many of these functions of Team Snap you will need to be in the full PC version not your phone.

In addition to games and scheduling Team Snap allows you to solicit and track volunteers and track team fees and payments so you may want to explore these items as well.

We encourage all Divisional Managers and Team Managers to reference the Team Snap webinars and help for the various activities they would like to do in the program as they provide these resources and are better training that we can provide.
