 https://pmha.bc.ca/registration/new-and-waitlisted-players/. Be sure to include player's birth certificate number, contact information including name, email address, physical address and phone number along with Respect in Sport Parent version certification number.
- Email the registrar <u>registrar@pmha.bc.ca</u> with the subject line "Residential transfer insert Last Name, First Name of Player" with the following information:
 - 1. Scanned copy of the "MHA RESIDENTIAL VERIFICATION &/OR TRANSFER CHECKLIST"
 - 2. Scanned copies of the 4 documents that are required (small file size or as separate pdfs)

STEP 2 (REGISTRAR)

- Upload documents in the Hockey Canada Registry
- Request player file transfer for new player
- Confirm Respect in Sport certification number
- Notify parent of successful player file transfer and provide registration link

STEP 3 (PARENT)
