 weeks included in month, 5% increase in rate they did not previously inform us, have not

3. New Business

- Arena updates
 - Installing temperature regulator
 - Once lacrosse box updated, focus on Panorama
 - Start with updates to change rooms, behind B rink mostly for Panthers, female change rooms and storage, adding more dressing rooms, no expansion of rinks, referee input
 - Need hockey minded people to give input
- Hockey Day in Canada Prep see above
- Tiering discussion (hopefully short)
 - VIAHA rep committee for tiering
 - o Every 3 years BC hockey reviews how they tier their rep teams
 - O We are a tier 2 association, if we have a B team, they are tier 3
 - Discuss adding tiers to competitive female hockey and smaller associations can't compete within their own, discussion putting in a second tier
 - Tiering within the hockey Canada pathway model for U11 we set it up similar to U13, put teams in divisions and they play each other, naming 'no A' team confuses HCR, B 1, 2, 3 instead
