 - U13 schedule issues for tournament has been resolved, Reign gave us an ice time

 month, develop plan and process to address the updates, goal is to meet once a month until
 the AGM, to be approved at the AGM

 - Would like to provide a gift certificate for Ken Haskel, scheduler for Victoria Minor Hockey, could not have done this year without him. Dave will go ahead and get the gift card and get reimbursement.

3. New Business

- Vote results for one-time stipend: 10 yes, 2 no
 - Supervised 19 games to ensure enough assessors were at each game so no games were canceled
 - o Should have allocated more budget towards covering assessors for all the games
 - This dollar value will take us over budget by approx. \$250. The difference will be recorded by our Treasurer and reallocated from Line 5625 of the budget (First Aid Kits) which is underbudget. This stipend will not impact our overall expense budget.
 - Motion: Board to approve transfer \$250 from budget line 5625 to 5255 to cover the stipend for Jason Fletcher – CARRIED
 - Lindsey will send message on behalf of the board, then will notify Treasurer to send etransfer
- Request for stipend for non-parent coach Brad McKell, for U13 house and Tom Moran, U11 C1 (Jono)
 - Stipend not in policy for U11, we have provided it in the past for an extenuating circumstance and qualified coach
 - o Brad is new to PMHA, had all his coaching credentials
 - Motion: to provide a stipend of \$1500 to Brad McKell in 2 installments of U13 C2 team as a non-parent assistant coach as per policy – CARRIED
 - Motion: to provide a stipend of \$1500 to Tom Moran in 2 installments of U11 C1 team as a non-parent assistant coach – NOT CARRIED
 - Jono will reply to Jacqui on that
- Panorama will start charging \$81.25 per event day to rent the parking lot for events like bottle drives. We are asking Panorama for an exemption. (Admin)
 - We can ask for exemption for cost of renting this room and parking lot up to a maximum of \$500 per year
 - Michelle will ask for exemption and get back to the board on this
- U13 teams complaining they are very unbalanced, Jono and Jason watched many games to review, determined they are balanced the issue was goaltending,
 - Found an enthusiastic U11 player who is actually U13 goalie, first year goalie/player, to play U13
 - U13 reign goalie has agreed to play on our team as well, dual rostered
 - U13 rec teams have a challenge with other associations not having more than 2 rep teams so there are a few players in rec who are significantly better than typical rec players
 - o PMHA U13 has 10 players who are brand new to hockey

- Similar issues in U15 and U18
- Lindsey is speaking with other association presidents to discuss separating into 2 divisions into lower level and higher level
- Steve said they did this a few years ago and it worked out well, more balanced games
 - Example: after Christmas, 16 teams in division, bottom 8 teams started new division and played against each other based on the records of the team
 - For example, VRC, PMHA, Sooke, Kerry Park would be in one, JDF, Victoria in another
- o JDF has a tier 1 team who takes players from Kerry Park and Sooke
- VRC is tier 1 association and takes players from PMHA
- Jono said north island is piloting program with tier 1 which includes Campbell River, Comox, TriPort, Powell River. Each association has a committee member with equal say. The association with the most players is the host team that year. Jono will report back on how that pilot program goes.
- U13 Rec struggling with development and could use Denise Bowles or Rob Armstrong for extra sessions. Would like to request PMHA help pay for this. (Chelsea)
 - Jason recommended goaltending and development for players, these have been presented to the coaches and C2 team coach still wants player movement, has not booked Rob Armstrong sessions yet
 - Coaches are less experienced
 - One goalie was very enthusiastic about being goalie, told can't be goalie during practice, does not focus at goalie development
 - o U11 C2 and C3 coaches did not go to goalie training for coaches
 - Not sure where to go from here for these teams, we have been in communication, provided lots of options, feel stuck
 - U18 goalies are coming to U13 rec practices
 - Provided plan to coach but it was not communicated to the families, it was sent to them eventually
 - Nolan will speak to the C2 coach about next steps, get registered for Rob Armstrong sessions, potentially give more ice for this team for extra development
